Individual, corporate or partnership tax returns from the last 2 years, including all schedules (federal only) A current profit and loss statement showing year-to-date revenues and expenses (if applicable)



Credit information (These documents are required only if they apply to your situation) A written explanation of any recent credit report A copy of the divorce decree or separate inquiries or late payments on your credit report agreement (if applicable) Bankruptcy discharge and schedule of creditors Alimony, child support or separate maintenance
